Sir,

Whereas your institution has been granted recognition from the academic year 2000-2001 vide order No. F.KR/ELE/61/SRO/NCTE/2000-2001/1570 dated 9.8.2000 with an intake of 30 to offer **Elementary** course.

The Performance Appraisal Report submitted by you vide letter dated, 17.4.2001 was reviewed by SRC. The conditions stipulated in the above said order holds good for the academic year 2001-2002 also and the following conditions are to be strictly adhered to :

1. The institution should maintain the minimum core staff of five qualified teachers and Principal as per NCTE norms.
2. All such teachers already appointed who do not fulfil the NCTE norms shall acquire the qualifications as per the NCTE norms before commencement of academic session 2002-2003.
3. All teaching and non-teaching staff should be paid approved pay scales as per NCTE norms and the salary should be disbursed through the individual account payee cheques. The bank statement of the whole year should be submitted to the SRC-NCTE while submitting the Performance Appraisal Report for the academic session 2001-2002.

4. Institution (Unaided) should maintain endowment and reserve fund as per NCTE norms and a letter from the Manager of the concerned bank should be submitted for having deposit of endowment and reserve fund and not taken any loan on the amount.

The institution shall continue to fulfil the norms laid down under the regulations of the NCTE and submit to the Regional Committee the Annual Report and the Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year. The performance appraisal report should inter alia give the extent of compliance of the conditions indicated above.
